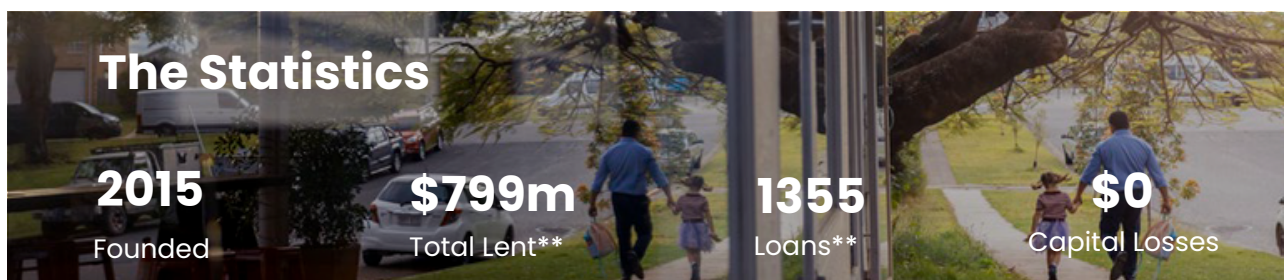
About Funding

A first charge over real-estate owned by the borrower. If there is a default in the repayment of the loan, the property can be sold to recover the loan.

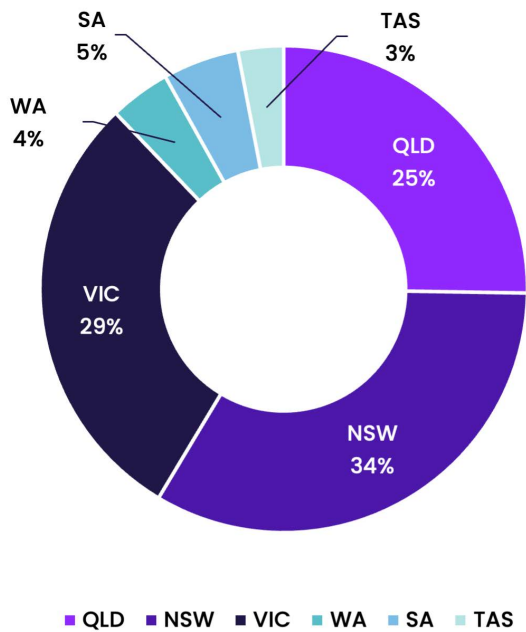

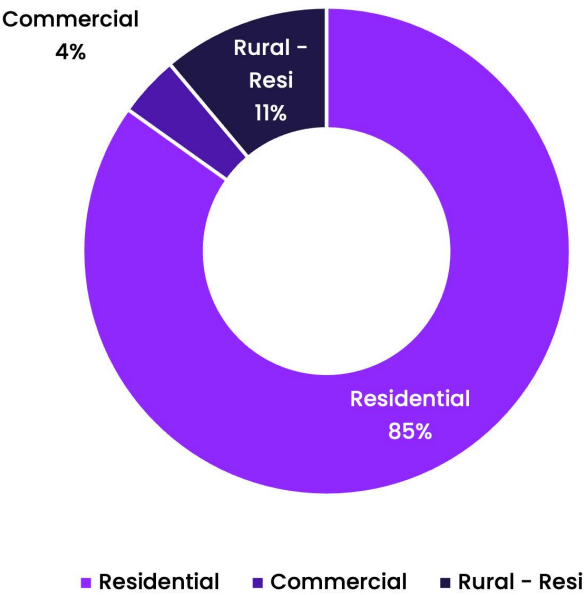
